

8. Results Service for 1982. Michael Lewis having retired from Pember & Boyle, they could no longer undertake the service. P. Chivers volunteered to produce results for 1982 but would resign as an A.S.S. The Hon. Secretary would attempt to resurrect Michael Lewis's computer programmes.

9. Prizes: the Commodore had secured a quotation for plates as follows:-

10" plate £2 each
8" plate £1.75 each
6" plate £1.75 each.

subject to a minimum order of 200 plates of each size.

These prices were thought acceptable by the Committee and, subject to finally agreeing the design, the Commodore was authorised to order 220 10", 210 8" and 170 6" plates, this being some 3-4 years' prizes.

10. The possibility of a two-tier subscription for 1982 was discussed but abandoned. However, it was agreed that the Club would offer a "Crew Information Service" for £10. Crew members who paid this fee would receive all regular C.C.R.C. mailings.

11. Freddie Kemp produced a sample of a sweater which might be the basis of a C.C.R.C. Club sweater. These sweaters could be obtained very reasonably but the cost of embroidering the Club burgee on them could be prohibitive. Freddie would obtain some more detailed costings.
